

Door Guard

Safety Enhancement

Fitting Instructions

The door guard consists of two main parts: the moving arm guard and the receiving plate. Seven fixing screws are supplied for installation as standard.

1. Fix the arm guard to the door frame at a height that suits you. Use the fixing screws supplied to securely fix to the door frame with the moving arm positioned to cover the door.

Note: We recommend that all screw holes are pre-drilled with a 1.5mm diameter drill bit.

2. Position the receiver plate on to the door sash and align with the moving arm so that the ball fits into the middle of the wider gap at the end of the moving arm. This is the point where the moving arm pivots.
3. Fix the receiver plate using the remaining screws.



Operation

To engage the door guard, pivot the moving arm across the receiver plate located on the sash. The ball on the receiver plate will engage with the arm guard to provide restricted opening of the door.

To disengage, ensure that the door is fully closed and pivot the moving arm away from the receiver plate to allow unrestricted opening of the door.

Maintenance

To clean your door guard, we recommend using a damp lint free cloth, followed by wiping dry with a clean lint free cloth.
